It's Beginning to Look a Lot Like Christmas

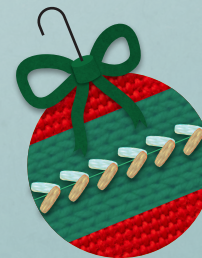
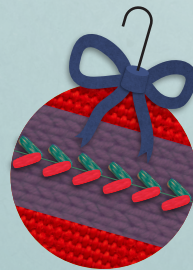
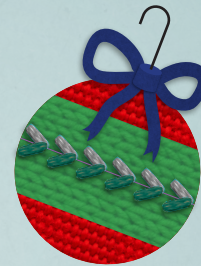
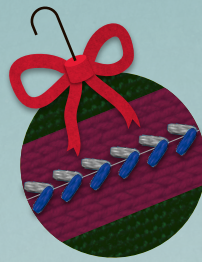
It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas

walking in a winter wonderland

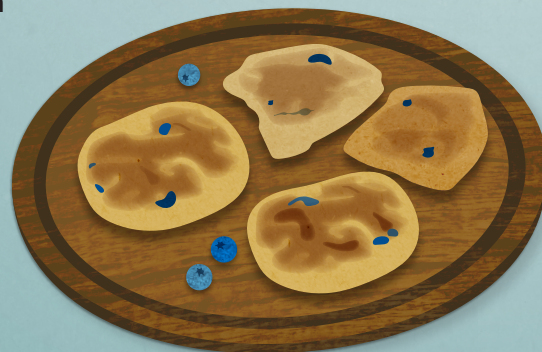
Gone away is the bluebird
