The position of Caseworker will be supervised by the manager of Mikiwam Program with Native Counselling Services of Alberta.

This is an exciting new program and currently we are looking for an individual as the caseworker for residents at Mikiwam Program

Specific responsibilities of the position include:

- Responsible for assisting individuals who are without housing transition into their own apartment and access support services.
- Assist individuals to set up realistic case plans to address barriers identified and ensure they have the appropriate income, identification etc.
- Refer individuals to appropriate community resources, advocate where necessary.

Our ideal candidate would have the following qualifications:

- **In-depth experience and working knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultures, healing and language.**
- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.
- Diploma or degree in human services and/or extensive working experience with Indigenous multi barrier individuals.
- Ability to work in a team environment as well as work independently with minimal supervision.
- Strong interpersonal and time management skills, ability to prioritize work daily.
- Must always maintain confidentiality, ability to work flexible hours and be on call as required.
- Extensive working experience with technology and computers.
- Professional appearance, boundaries, and behaviours suitable for the work.
- Must complete a criminal record and child intervention check.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta driver's license with required liability insurance and confirmation of insurance coverage to transport clients.
