GENERAL RULES AND ENTRY

- 1. The Competition is a skill-based competition and is open to **all skill levels**. No purchase is necessary to enter the Competition or to win a prize.
- 2. Entry for the Competition opens on June 22, 2024 @ 11AM.
- 3. All Competition entries must be done in person at Métis crossing prior to 3PM June 22, 2024.

- 8. In the event of a tie, the entrants will be asked to do another round of jigging (2 or 3 changes depending on the category). Previous scores will be included in the new tally.
- 9. A fiddler will be provided and will play the Red River Jig.

ELIGIBILITY

The Competition is open to all MNA citizens and self-identifying Métis. Employees of the MNA, their affiliates, advertising and promotional agencies, service providers, performers and judges are not eligible to enter the Competition or to win a prize.

JIGGING (RED RIVER JIG) COMPETITION CATEGORIES

- Mini Métis: 0 to 6 years of age
- Junior Between 7 and 11 years of age
- Youth Between 12 and 17 years of age
- Adult Between 18 and 59 years of age
- Senior age category 60 years of age and older

All age categories will have 2 changes.

JUDGING

All judging decisions are final and binding and not subject to review or appeal.

This is a traditional Jigging (Red River Jig) competition. There will be a panel of three judges.

The jigging will be judged on skill, timing and creativity.
