VOTING DETAILS

IN-PERSON VOTING

There will be **1** polling location in the following community:

Poll Station Hours: 8am – 8pm



Pursuant to the Election Law, Voters must be Citizens of the Métis Nation within Alberta, must be sixteen (16) years of age or older before the closing of voting (November 5, 2024), and must have been ordinarily resident in the Fort Edmonton Métis District (District #9) for at least 90 days before the close of voting to be entitled to vote in this election.

MAIL-IN VOTING

- A mail-in ballot package will be sent via mail on October 8, 2024, to each Citizen who is eligible to vote.
- Mail-in ballot packages will be sent to the address on file with the Otipemisiwak Métis Government.
- If a mail-in ballot is not received or a replacement mail-in ballot package is required, Citizens should make a request for their replacement mail-in ballot package no later than 14 days prior to the final day of the vote. Requests for replacement mail-in ballot packages may be made to the Office of the Chief Electoral by email or by phone.

ELECTRONIC VOTING

- Electronic voting will be open for the entire duration of the voting period (October 29 - November 5, 2024).
- Registration for electronic voting will be made available on October 19, 2024.
