Reporting to the Senior Manager of Health, Children, and Youth, the RPC will facilitate the development of Evidence-Based Cancer Prevention Strategies that Support Alberta Métis citizens.

Major Responsibilities

- Conduct a Literature review on various topics related to cancer topics and the types of programs available specific to travel and accommodations.
- Coordinate the development and implementation of a Pilot Project: Cancer-related Transportation Services for Métis Patients Living in Northern/Rural/Remote Communities
- Coordinate the Development of a comprehensive tool on Métis-specific Cancer Journey
- Coordinate and Facilitate focus groups specific to cancer within the Métis community.
- Facilitate Cancer prevention education workshops and Métis health awareness initiatives.
- Develop relationships with the Métis community, University of Alberta, and other key stakeholders with the intent of achieving effective delivery of the pilot project.
- Supporting the MNA/UofA research team as required.
