Aim: Support native bees throughout Alberta with the help of Métis Citizens

Native Bees have
pollinated our gardens,
meadows, and crops
long before the European
Honeybee was introduced
to North America
in the 1600s



- 240 MNA Citizens received a bee nesting box to place on their property this summer.
- In Fall 2022, participating Citizens will fill out a monitoring form and report back to the MNA on the bee activity in their nesting box.

How does this program help native bees?

- The nesting box provides solitary native bees with a safe and clean place to lay their eggs year after year
- Wildflowers provide native bees with important food sources (pollen and nectar)





What's in the kit?

- Bee Nesting Box (two different styles) and instructions
- Native bee informational pamphlets provided by the Edmonton & Area Land Trust
- A pack of Alberta native wildflower seeds

Risks to Native Bees:

- Invasive species
- Disease
- Pollution
- Climate change
