
MÉTIS CROSSING SOLAR PROJECT (MCSP)

The Métis Crossing Solar Project (MCSP) is a 4.86-megawatt AC community generation solar project located at Métis Crossing. The project is in collaboration with the MNA, Town of Smoky Lake, and Smoky Lake County. The goal is to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and generate economic and community benefits for the partnering communities.

- Largest wholly Métis-owned solar project in Alberta
- Model project for Indigenous partnership, social and environmental benefits
- Key initiative under the MNA Climate Change Action Plan
