**Original documents are not required:** You may submit photocopies or scans of your documents with your application package. Any missing information or documentation will result in a processing delay of your application.

### Before you apply, make sure you have:

- The child's Otipemisiwak Métis Government Citizenship number

- The name of the product, service, or support requested
- Contact information of the vendor/service provider
- Contact information of the professional providing the referral
- A summary of the child's history and unique needs that should be considered to support the request
