VOTING DETAILS

Voters must be Métis Nation within Alberta Citizens, (16) years of age or older to be entitled to vote. Voters must be ordinarily resident in District 9, Fort Edmonton Métis District for at least 90 days before the close of voting to be entitled to vote for District Council.

The addresses for each polling location are to be determined, along with any additional locations that may be deemed necessary and approved by the Chief Electoral Officer in consultation with the District.



All polling station hours will operate from 8am to 8pm. Dates for polling station are listed below.

In-Person Voting

There will be **1** polling location in the following community for District 9, Fort Edmonton Métis District.

- Edmonton North (November 3, 4 and 5, 2024)

Mail-in Voting

- A mail-in ballot package will be sent via mail to each Citizen that is eligible to vote.
- Mail-in ballot packages will be sent to the address on file with the MNA.
- If a mail-in ballot is not received, or a replacement mail-in ballot package is required, Citizens should make this request no later than 10 days prior to the final day of the vote.

Electronic Voting

Electronic voting will be open for the entire duration of the voting period which is from October 29 - November 5, 2024.
