DECISION OF THE OTIPEMISIWAK MÉTIS GOVERNMENT JUDICIAL TRIBUNAL RE: ELECTION APPEAL 2025-07: WRITTEN OR ORAL SUBMISSIONS

As per Section 115(1) of the *Elections and Referenda Act*, members of the Otipemisiwak Métis Government Judicial Tribunal have decided whether the above-mentioned appeal will be determined by oral or written submissions.

It was decided that this appeal will be determined by **written submission**, with timelines for submission as follows:

If the Appellant William Loutitt has any further submissions, they must be submitted to the Judicial Tribunal **no later than 12:00 pm on Monday, November 24, 2025.**

If the Respondent Kelly Myers has any written submissions, they must be submitted to the Judicial Tribunal **no later than 12:00 pm on Monday, December 8, 2025.**

Further, the Judicial Tribunal asks that the Chief Electoral Officer or the Elections' Office provide their interim report on the election in question, or in the event that such a report is not yet available, that the Chief Electoral Officer or the Elections' Office provide the Judicial Tribunal with the information that would normally be included in an election report, including any information available on the electronic voting process used for the election in question, and asks that the information be provided **no** later than 12:00 pm on Monday, December 8, 2025.
